Food Sanitation Certificates at Malcolm X College

A Certified Food Service Sanitation Manager is required to be on duty at all times when Time/Temperature Control for Safety Foods (TCS foods) is prepared or served. This person is responsible for overseeing the food handling and preparation process to prevent the occurrence of food-borne illness.

If you have passed the approved Food Service Sanitation Certification course, you can apply in person for the City of Chicago Food Service Sanitation Manager Certificate at Malcolm X College, 1900 Jackson Blvd Suite 0203 Chicago, IL 60612. Upon arriving at MXC check in with security and ask for directions to the Food Service Sanitation Program.

Applications are accepted during the following times:

9 AM to 4:30 PM Monday – Thursday 9 AM to 12:30 PM Friday

To complete the application process successfully, bring the following printed documents:

□ National Food Protection Manager Certificate from testing agency.

☐ TAP Series course certificate.

□ Valid Picture ID.

□ \$52.00 Cash or Money Order only.

If a proxy is applying on your behalf, you will need to provide a written note giving your permission to the proxy. The note must be signed and dated.

Your City of Chicago Food Service Sanitation Certificate will be mailed to your home address.

Getting to Malcolm X College:

By public transit: Several transit routes run adjacent to the college including the CTA Blue Line (Illinois Medical District stop) and the CTA bus #157, 126, and 50.

By car: Cars access Malcolm X College via Jackson Blvd. The Malcolm X College parking garage is accessible via Jackson Blvd. When conducting business at the college parking is free with validation. The security desk located at the Jackson Blvd entrance validates parking tickets.
